Yes. . they look different, and yes they feel different than other skis. The new DOUBLE Deck actually adjusts to the skier's speed and desired turn shape. The ski reacts more dynamically as the skier's energy and input increase. Rebound is controlled by the skier's input; get on 'em hard and they will accelerate out of the turn. Cruise and take a more subtle approach, and the D2 applies its best manners, with a smooth confident ride that rivals the best all mountain cruisers. This is a new approach to the "one ski quiver" and Atomic has developed new technology that is undeniably "the better mousetrap" for skilled skiers who crave the latest pro-active innovation, while refusing to fall for the gimmicks and electronics that fall short of the desired mark. Pro-active will always be better than re-active and we love this ski.

Atomic *D2 SL*

To race or not to race. This is the latest "Short turn missile" from Atomic's new DOUBLE Deck family and the new D2 SL with its 11.5m radius (at 165 cm) is both quick and smooth; 2 qualities that are seldom used in the same phrase when describing skis. The leaf spring effect of the top section allow the D2 SL to ski faster than other Slalom designs, by dampening the forces usually transmitted back to skier. The result smooth connected turns with a bullish confidence that translates to big fun for the skier who brings his or her skill set to every run. Our testers rated this ski "one of the BEST for "front side" carving and ripping." "Wow, this ski in a 170cm length does everything! Slalom and GS."
